# Council Partnership Pilot Program (CPPP)

## - Water efficiency for smaller businesses

It can be hard for small to medium water using businesses to properly review their water and energy use. This can be due to a lack of time, information and money. Small to medium water using businesses use between 10,000 and 80,000 litres of water a day and account for over 28% of all water use in the Sydney catchment area.

To help these businesses, Sydney Water has partnered with 17 local councils.

Across these councils, 21 environmental officers are working one-on-one with over 500 small to medium water using businesses.

The program provides free water efficiency assessments in the participating council areas. This includes expert advice on how to save water.

More than 130 businesses have taken advantage of the free water efficiency assessments. The assessments have identified over 225,000 litres of water savings a day.
